

Save Our Bees



he UK Government has recently reversed a ban on a bee-killing neonicotinoid pesticide for the third year running.

Bees' disappearance will trigger a devastating cycle of events for our wildlife, environment and the food we eat. To avoid this, the Government must support farmers to explore long-term, agroecological solutions that don't threaten our endangered bee population.

Many of us will know that the Bee is a Manchester emblem, highlighted after the Arena Bombing in 2017.

To do our part maybe an action would be to Grow purple flowers for bees



Best plants for bees - purple flowers.

Bees can see the colour purple more clearly than any other colour, and some of the best bee plants, such as lavender, alliums, buddleia and catmint, have purple flowers. That said, many flowers in other colours will still attract bees, so don't pull them up!
